Implementation Plan		
Model	Prompt	Check
<p>This should be an ongoing skill beginning on day one. Most often daily weather is done at Circle Time at the beginning of the day. Teach weather concepts at that time. After reading <i>Worms Like to Wiggle</i>, go back and point out the details like the sun and blue skies. Then have the kids tell you what type of weather is in the story.</p>	<p>Ask “what if” questions with the children. Ask them questions like “What if there were clouds in the story?” That is a good way to review weather concepts outside of Circle Time.</p>	<p>Have the kids make observations about weather every morning in Circle Time.</p>
