Model	Prompt	Check
<p>On your second week of reading <i>Worms Like to Wiggle</i>, have the kids play a listening game. Write the letter W on the board. Tell the kids the sound w makes and have the kids repeat it. Leap Frog has a product called "Fridge Phonics Magnetic Set". When you place the letter in the base it sings a letter sound song. This would be great to use. The kids will put their thumb up every time they hear the letter w. Model some examples of words that begin with w such as worm and wiggle. The first time you do this make sure to put your thumb up every time there is a word with w at the beginning.</p>	<p>The second and third time you are doing this with the kids, make sure you give some wait time and then reinforce by putting your thumb up when a word with w comes up.</p>	<p>On the fifth time you do this, don't put your thumb up. Just watch the kids and see who is putting their thumb up. You could do this with any other letter.</p>



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
