Model	Prompt	Check
<p><i>Worms Like to Wiggle</i> was written in a rhyming pattern. Each time you read the story emphasize the words that rhyme. Write them on the board. Print out the Rhyming Words Word Sort. Pair each word with its picture. Go through each pair of words. Allow the kids to come up with their own rhyming words...even if they aren't words.</p>	<p>Present just the pictures to the children. As a class decide which ones rhyme. Put the pictures next to each other on the board. When you reread the book, go over again which words rhyme.</p>	<p>Have the sort available at the art center. Let the kids color the pictures. Help them to put the two that rhyme next to each other.</p> <p>Have parents who have access to the book to reinforce this at home.</p>
