Implementation Plan		
Model	Prompt	Check
<p>Before reading the story, do a picture walk through of the book. Look at all of the pictures. As you point to pictures, the children can label them. They will also probably want to point and show you what else they know. As you read the book to the children, emphasize the different animal names.</p>	<p>After reading the book a few times, have the children fill in what animals are wiggling. Then read the rest of the sentence. For example on page three and four point to the worm and say "What animal?" Then say, "Good, Worms like to wiggle in the dark moist ground." Not only will this increase the child's ability to label objects but it will increase their listening attention because they are an active part of the story.</p>	<p>Now, to check and see if the children are able to label items from the book print and make the "Counting the Animals" manipulatives. Have the children come up to the magnetic board/ felt board and pick an animal. Let them tell the class what it is and show how it wiggles.</p>
