Implementation Plan		
Model	Prompt	Check
<p>When reading through the story, have the kids make observations on each page. Make sure that they all notice the sun out on the different pages. Point outside and show that when the sun is in the sky it is the day time. Ask the kids what activities happen during the day. Take the kids outside on a nice day to demonstrate how the sun can make things hot or warm outside. Tell the kids that this is called the temperature. Remind them that, like in the story, the sun comes out during the day. The temperature in the story is probably warm or hot too.</p>	<p>The next time reading the story, ask the kids if they think it is day time in the story or if it is night time. If they don't know prompt them by reminding them of the sun being out. Also ask them if they think it is hot or cold. Ask them why they think that. Remind them of the trip outside and that the sun comes out during the day and makes it warm or hot outside.</p>	<p>To assess if the children understand the concepts, ask questions as you read through the story. Make sure they can tell you the story takes place in the day time and that it is probably warm or hot. The more advanced kids should be able to tell you how they know that.</p>
